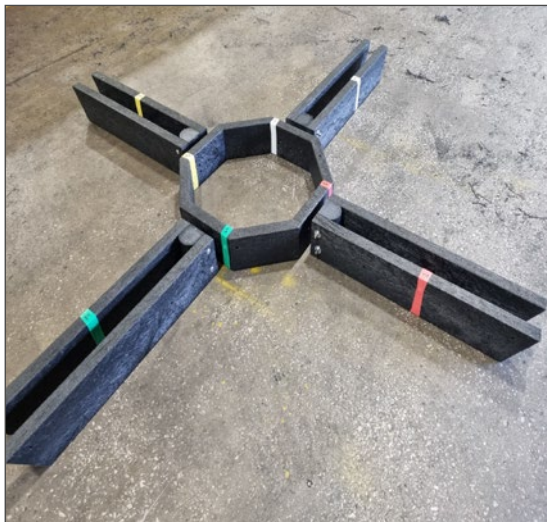


OCTAGONAL 8 SEATER PICNIC TABLE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



1 Prepare the base ring. Begin by placing the inner ring flat on the floor, ensuring the side marked "BOTTOM" is facing downwards. This will form the central support structure for your table. Work on a flat, level surface to ensure accuracy during assembly.

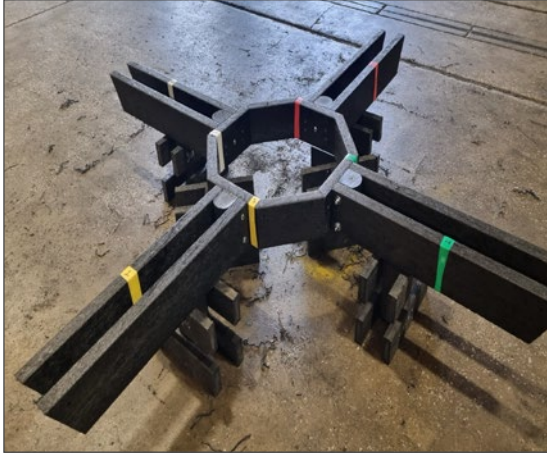


2 Lay out all parts. Refer to the image and arrange all parts around the inner ring. Each section is colour-coded to guide assembly - for example, green to green, red to red, and so on. Make sure the matching colours are facing each other on each side before you start fixing.



3 Fix each side. Secure each side of the base as shown in the image using 4 x 150mm screws and 1 x M8 x 150mm bolt, washer, nut, and dome nut supplied. Repeat this process for all four sides until the base frame is complete. Tighten the screws and bolts enough to hold everything in position, but do not over-tighten until all sections are assembled.

4 Support the frame. Once the four sides are connected, raise and support the entire base frame 260mm off the ground (as shown in the image below). This allows enough clearance to fit the legs and seat supports comfortably in the following steps.



5 Position the seats. Lay out the seat sections on each side, ensuring that the colour-coded parts match correctly. Check that each piece aligns neatly with the frame before moving to the next stage.



6 Fit the legs. Using the correct colour-coded legs, insert one on each side, making sure the end marked "TOP" is facing upwards. Align the pre-drilled holes in the base frame with those in the legs, then fix using 1 x M8 x 200mm bolt, washer, nut, and dome nut for each side. Repeat this process on all four sides before moving on.

7 Check the structure. After fitting all the legs, your table should resemble the image below - an even octagonal shape with all colour-coded parts matching on every side. Double-check that all joints are tight and that the frame is level before fitting the table top.



8 Attach the table top. Line up the arrows marked on the underside of the table top with one of the legs. This ensures correct orientation. Carefully lift the table top into position (two people are recommended) and align the pre-drilled holes in the underside of the table top with those on the legs. Fix in place using 4 x M8 x 180mm bolts, washers, nuts, and dome nuts supplied - one for each side of the table.



9 Final tightening and finishing. Once all bolts are fitted and aligned, tighten everything securely. Remove any marking tape from the components.

Before finalising, make sure the number on the underside of the table top corresponds with the same number marked on the rest of the component parts - this confirms the correct alignment.

Your octagonal picnic table is now complete and ready for use.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

To keep your Cladco picnic table looking its best:

- ✓ Check all bolts and fixings periodically and re-tighten if necessary, especially after periods of heavy use or weather changes.
- ✓ Clean with mild soapy water and a soft brush or cloth; avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive pads.
- ✓ For outdoor use, position the table on a level surface and, if possible, rotate occasionally to help reduce uneven weathering.

Following these simple steps will help maintain the stability, safety and finish of your Cladco octagonal picnic table for years to come.
